Health: Aphekom findings add new dimension to health impacts and costs of air pollution in European cities

The project shows that life expectancy and monetary benefits increase significantly when levels of fine particles are reduced further in European cities; it reveals that living near busy roads substantially increases the total burden of disease attributable to air pollution; and it underscores the benefits from regulating pollution near busy roads beyond the achievements of current EU legislation.
