Authors are encouraged to submit manuscripts on theoretical and clinical topics in neuropsychology, broadly understood. Interdisciplinary studies that explore issues not previously regarded as strictly neuropsychological are particularly welcome.

Acta Neuropsychologica, though it is the official publication of the Polish Neuropsychological Society, is an international, English-language publication. The Editorial Board includes not only representatives from the sponsoring Society, but also many noted specialists from around the world, representing various specialties, not only neuropsychology, but also neurolinguistics, neurology, and neurosurgery, among others.
